1. A waiter had 30,002 customers. If 2,830 left, how many customers would the waiter still have?

2) For a party Kaleb bought 70,001 cupcakes. If 1,618 were eaten, how many cupcakes would Kaleb have left?

3) There were 8,020 on the box. 1,532 people got off the bus. How many people were left on the bus?

4) At the arcade Ned had won 70,005 tickets. If he used 30,778 to buy some toys, how many tickets did Ned have left?

5) A clown had 20,003 balloons. He gave 17,922 away at a party. How many balloons does he still have?

6) At the arcade Dave had won 10,007 tickets. He used 5,772 tickets. How many tickets did he had at the end?

7) For a birthday party a clown came with 10,003 balloons. He gave away 7,935 balloons. How many balloons did he take back with him?

8) A museum had 50,008 paintings. After they got rid of some, they had 34,441 left. How many paintings did they get rid of?

9) John had 40,001 apps on his phone. After deleting some, he had 11,444 left. How many apps did he delete?

10) Emily had some candy. She gave her friend 70,003 pieces and had 54,717 left. How many pieces did she have to start with?

11) A pet store had 80,007 gerbils. After selling some, they had 32,720 left. How many did they sell?

12) Jerry had a bag of 40,006 marbles. Later, he gave 2,375 marbles to his brother. How many marbles does Jerry have left?

13. Sam's favorite book trilogy had 1,498 pages total. If he read 684 pages on this first try. How many pages does he have left to read?

14. In one season a farmer picked 1,415 potatoes. If 764 of them were bad and he sold another 496 of them, how many did he have left?

15. Ned had 1,800 dollars in his bank account. If he took out 794 to buy some games and another 589 for new clothes how much money is left in his account?
