4. If ends in f or fe, change the f, fe to **ves**.  
(leaf = lea**ves**)

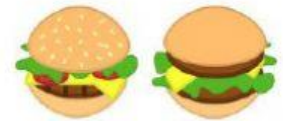

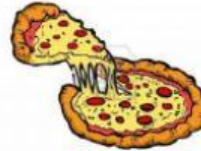
