SECOND CONDITIONAL



PRESENT situations impossible / improbable / very unlikely to change.

IF + PAST SIMPLE, + WOULD/WOULDN'T + VERB (INFINITIVE)

(CONDITION)

(RESULT/EFFECT)

If I had money, I would travel everywhere
(But I DON'T HAVE any money, so I CAN'T TRAVEL.)

If my parents were celebrities, they would be very famous.
(But my parents AREN'T celebrities, so they AREN'T famous.)

If I were you...

MEANING:

You imagine yourself in the position
or situation of the other person.
It is used **TO GIVE ADVICE**.



If I were you,	+	I would + verb
If I were you,		I would study more.
If I were you,		I wouldn't do that.
I would + verb	+	if I were you
I would go to the doctor		if I were you.
I wouldn't go there		if I were you.



If I were you, I wouldn't eat that.



I would be careful if I were you.

Why If I were and not If I was?

This is the **SUBJUNCTIVE** mood which is used for
HYPOTHETICAL situations. It is a condition which is
contrary to fact (the fact is, I am **NOT** you).
With **TO BE**, use **WERE** for all subjects in the **SUBJUNCTIVE**.
