Rentap

Rentap was a famous Dayak (Iban) warrior in Sarawak. He rebelled against the White Rajah or James Brooke when the latter tried to drive the Ibans out of Skrang. Rentap attacked James Brooke's fort at Skrang River. He successfully drove James Brooke's side out of Skrang.

James then burnt Rentap's village. Rentap retreated to Bukit Sadok and built himself a fort there. He thwarted many plans by James Brooke to control Skrang and Saribas areas. Only after many attempts and with aid of bigger cannons did James Brooke defeat Rentap in the year 1861. Though defeated, Rentap never officially surrendered. He retreated to Ulu Entabai and died in the same place in 1863.
