✓ Use the preposition **AT** with: parts of the day, _____, points in time.

Ex: **At** night, **At** 7:00 o'clock, **At** Easter

✓ Use the preposition **ON** with _____, _____, a particular part of the day.

Ex: **On** Sunday, **On** December 25th, **On** the morning of September 11th.
