

COGNATES are words that are **SIMILAR** in 2 languages. Make your best guess for the **ENGLISH** word based on the German word. Not all the words have text boxes to fill in. Fill in the 25 I have made.

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German Cognates

You already know many German words. Some German words are spelled exactly like English words and have the same meanings: **Ball, Name, Hand, Sofa, warm, wild**. Many other German words are spelled almost like English words, differing only in one or two letters: **Amerika, Fisch, Kaffee, Prinz**. In these words and many others, English hard *c* becomes German **k**, English *sh* becomes German **sch**, and English soft *c* becomes German **z**. Some other German cognates have two dots — called Umlaut — over the vowels **a, o, and u**. This Umlaut changes the pronunciation of the vowel: **Bäcker** = *baker*, **Öl** = *oil*, **grün** = *green*.
