Form: Have + V3
Has

Subject + have + often + V3 +
has never

e.g: I have written three stories.

Negation: We use (not) after (have, has)

e.g: I have not written three stories.

+ subject + V3 +?

Has

e.g: Have you written three stories?

Wh-questions:

Have

Wh-word+ + subject + V3 +?

Has

e.g: What have you written?
