

WAYS OF WALKING

Movement when lying flat on the ground

You put your foot down awkwardly while you are walking and nearly fall over

The way a baby walks : unsteady

Sudden haste or rapid movement of short

Associated with the idea of being late or behind.

You move to a place holding your hands in front of you and feeling the way because you can't see anything

To walk heavily in a particular direction or along roads or streets

Travel around an area without having a particular purpose

To walk very unsteadily as if you are about to fall

To walk with difficulty or in an uneven way because one of one's legs or feet is hurt

A rapid short run to reach a determined objective

Walk around a place in a casual way often without intending to go in any particular direction

To walk in a slow relaxed way

You keep walking within a small area, often because you are anxious or impatient
