Likely It'sa party for Simon's Birthday.

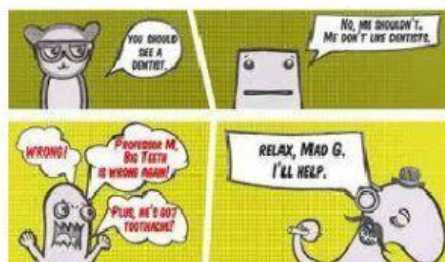
