The Moon is the satellite of the Earth. It is about the quarter size of the Earth. It goes around the Earth approximately in one month. It is about 384,000 kilometers away from the Earth. There is no air or atmosphere around it, so there is no life on the Moon. It has about 13 and a half days of daylight and 13 and a half days of darkness. Temperature on the Moon is 120°C during the lunar day and -150°C during the lunar night. Because there is no air or atmosphere, there is also no sound as the sound waves travel through the air. So, the Moon is very silent.

On July 20, 1969, two American astronauts, Neil Armstrong and Edwin Aldrin were the first men to walk on the Moon. It was the United States first lunar mission. Armstrong was the Mission Commander and Michael Collins and Aldrin were the pilots.
