Ocean's Eleven is a comedy thriller that was a big hit in 2001. Directed by Steven Soderbergh, it was based on another film on the same title that was made in 1960. It stars George Clooney, Brad Pitt and Matt Damon, and there are many other well-known actors too.

The film tells the story of Danny Ocean, a gangster that comes out of prison and organises a group of friends to rob a casino in Las Vegas. The plot is not easy to understand, but, on the whole, the details of the story are not terribly important.

The script is very funny and the acting is excellent. I was especially impressed by Brad Pitt, who played the character of Rusty Ryan. The scenes that are set in the casino are particularly gripping and the suspense will keep you on the edge of your seat.
