

## PHRASAL VERBS: TURN

**DOWN:** - not accept an invitation or offer  
- decrease volume

**AROUND:** change direction

**IN:** -give an assignment to a teacher  
- go to bed  
- deliver a criminal to the police

### TURN

**UP:** - appear  
- increase

**INTO:** become

**ON:** start a machine, light

**OFF:** stop a machine, light

**OUT:** have a particular result, often unexpected
