Negative sentence	I You We They	have	never	Past Participle .
	He She It	has		

Example: I **have never done** the long jump.

Interrogative sentence	Have	you we they	ever	Past Participle ?
	Has	he she it		

Answer:

Yes, I/you/ they/ we **have**.

Yes, he/ she/ it **has**.

No, I/you/ they/ we **have never + past participle**.

No, he/ she/ it **has never + past participle**.

Example:

Have you **ever done** the long jump?

Yes, I **have done** the long jump.

No, I **have never done** the long jump.
