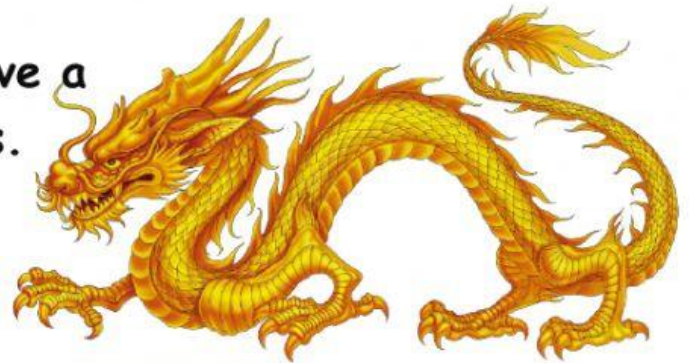
In Greek , Cerberus is a three-headed dog that guards the gates of the Underworld.
