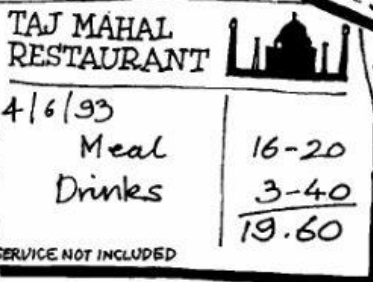
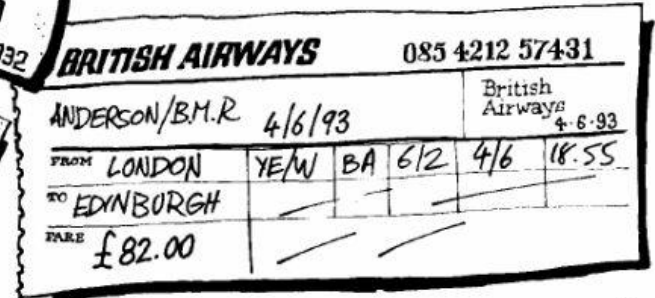




DETECTIVE 'ALIBI'
