Dear Penny,

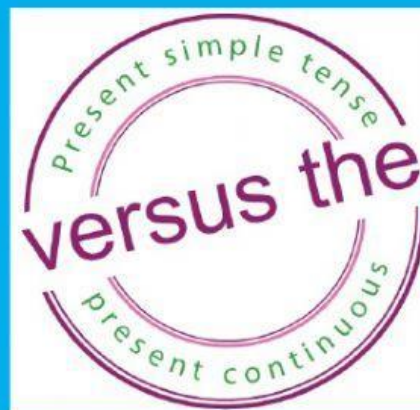
Greetings from Sao Paulo, Brazil, where my family and I (spend) our summer holidays this year.
