Negative
I/You <b>don't like</b> fish.
He/She/It <b>doesn't like</b> fish.
We/You/They <b>don't like</b> fish.
Interrogative
<b>Do</b> I/you <b>like</b> fish?
<b>Does</b> he/she/it <b>like</b> fish?
<b>Do</b> we/you/they <b>like</b> fish?
Short answers
Yes, I/you <b>do</b> ./No, I/you <b>don't</b> .
Yes, he/she/it <b>does</b> ./No, he/she/it <b>doesn't</b> .
Yes, we/you/they <b>do</b> ./No, we/you/they <b>don't</b> .
