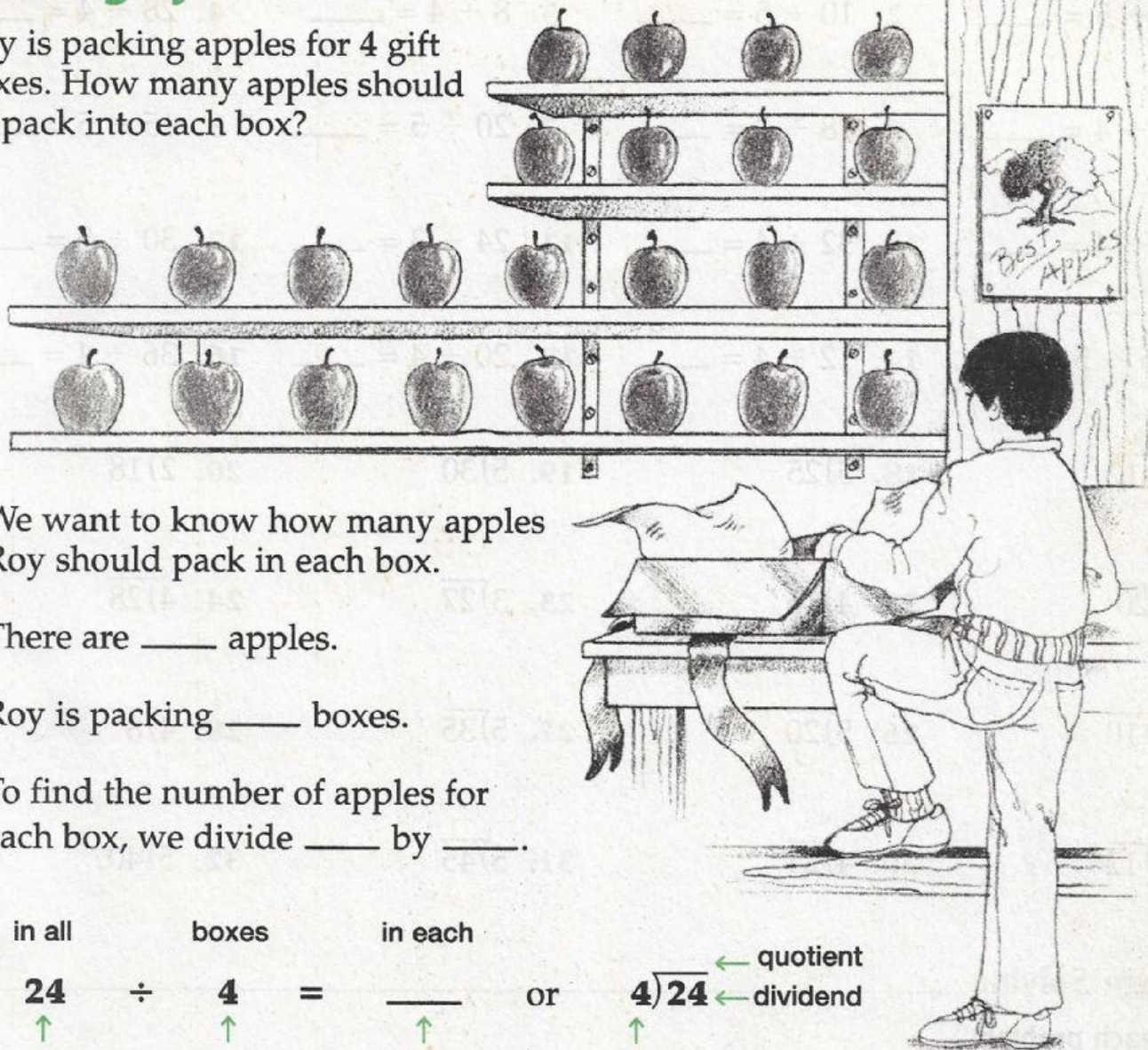


Dividing by 4 or 5
