- > Cases continue to rise in Saskatchewan
- > Highest number of cases in SK are in Saskatoon
- > New restrictions - indoor private gatherings are limited to 5 people
 - indoor public gatherings are limited to 30 people (with 2m distance)
- > Do you always follow these guidelines?
- > Are you getting tired of these guidelines?
- > Do you know people who **don't** follow the guidelines? (2m distance, mask-wearing)
- > Do you know someone who has/had COVID-19?

Remember...the teacher is looking for:

- a story in paragraph format
- correct use of capital letters
- correct end punctuation (periods, question marks, exclamation marks)
- correct verb tenses
- a subject and verb in every sentence
- CLB 3: Four to five sentences / CLB 4: Six to seven sentences

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
