Contraction

I'm your teacher.
You're in room 13.
He's James.
She's Marta.
It's a school.
We're students.
You're in Class 2.
They're teachers.

B

- Use capital *I*. *I'm your teacher*. NOT *i'm*.
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- *you* = singular and plural.
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- Use *he* for a man, *she* for a woman, and *it* for a thing.
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- Use *they* for people and things.
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- In contractions '=' a missing letter, e.g. 'm = am.
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- Use contractions in conversation.
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• Frequent mistakes
