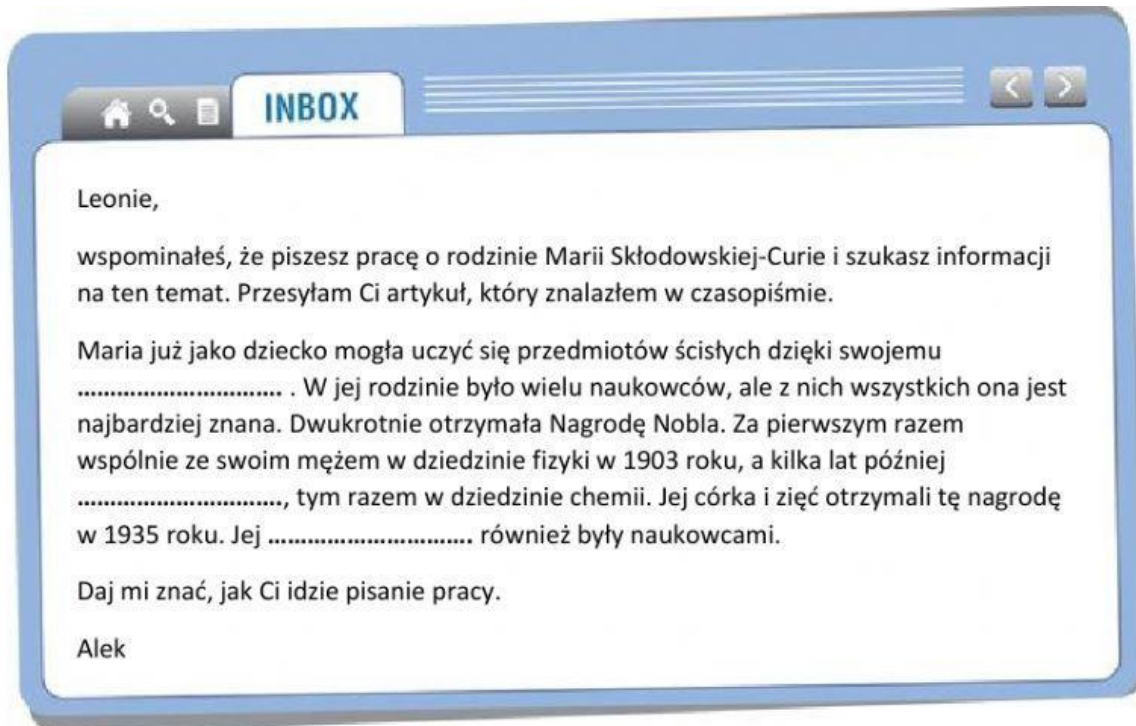

A Scientific Family

Maria Skłodowska-Curie was born in Poland in 1867. Her father was a scientist who taught his children in a home laboratory. Women weren't allowed to go to university at the time, so Maria had to study in secret. She continued her studies in Paris, where she met her husband Pierre. Together, Maria and her husband won the Nobel Prize in Physics in 1903 after making some important scientific discoveries. Maria won the Nobel Prize alone in 1911, for chemistry, and her daughter, Irène, went on to win this same prize in 1935, with her husband, Frédéric. Maria's grandchildren went on to have successful careers as biologists and physicists.
