Use *at* for a definite time.
Use *in* for months and parts of the day.
Use *on* for days and dates.
Use *from . . . to* for a period of time.

at 1:30	in the morning	on Saturday	from 2:00 p.m.	to 3:00 p.m.
night	January	the weekend	Tuesday	Friday

QUESTIONS

When **do** you **go** to work?
does he **have** class?

ANSWERS

I **go** to work **at** 8 o'clock.
He **has** class **on** Monday.
