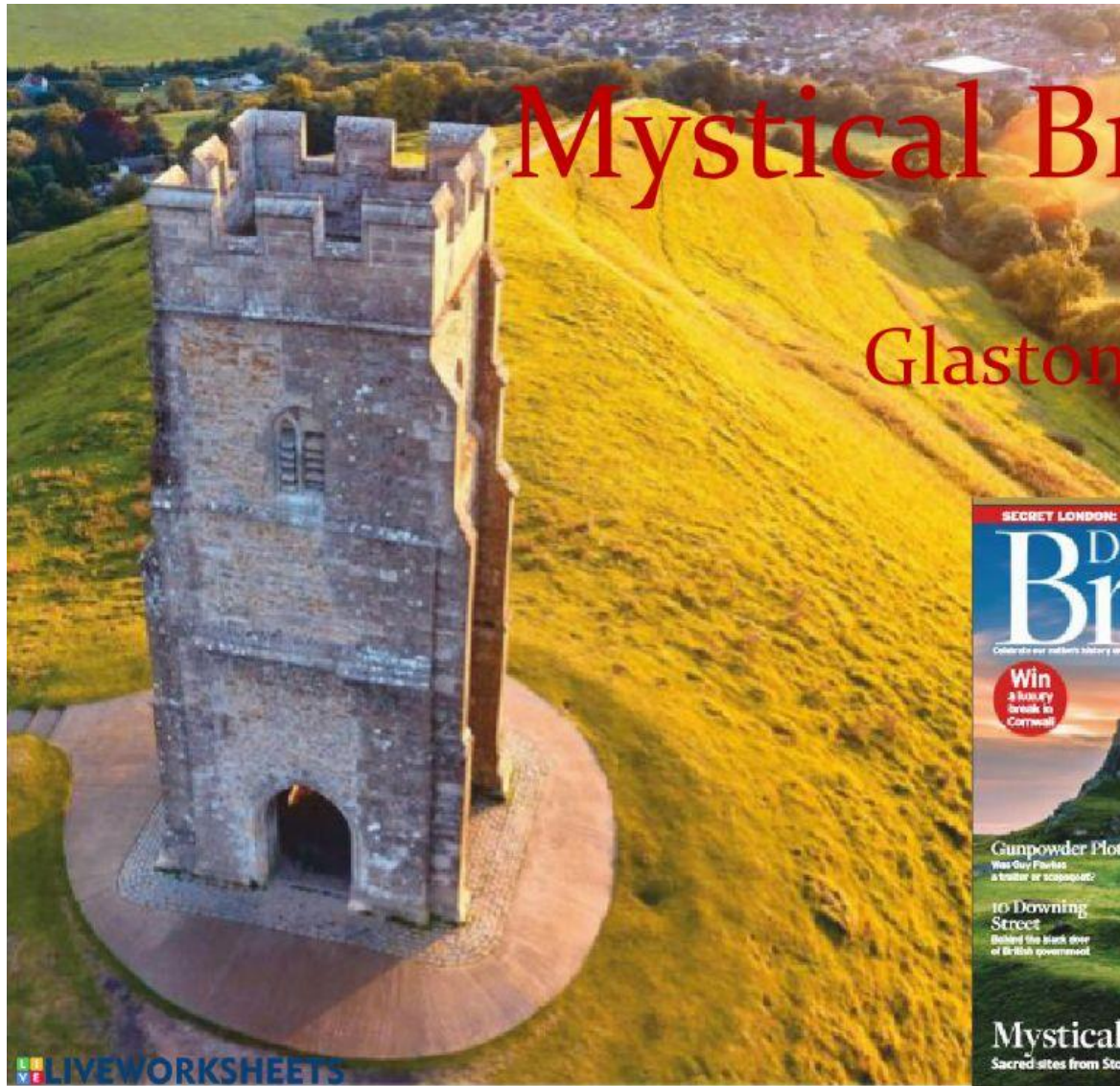

The Glastonbury festival at Worthy Farm in Somerset is ____1____ and ____2____ of its kind in the world, ____3____ attracting more than 200,000 visitors for five days of music, performing arts and general revelry. The event ____4____ life, however, as the free Pilton Pop, Blues and Folk Festival in 1970, with ____5____ attracted by the mysticism connected to the area, and in particular the nearby Glastonbury Tor.

Rising from the Somerset Levels, the Tor ____6____ of the 14th-century St Michael's Church tower sat atop a clay-and-Blue Lias hill into which are set seven terraces.

Archaeological excavations nearby have revealed evidence of Neolithic and Dark Age settlements, yet it is the more recent yet unprovable stories connected to the Tor that have established its mystical reputation. Many believe that this is the site of Avalon, the island on which King Arthur's sword Excalibur ____7____. Others believe that the terraces hide a Neolithic labyrinth or even the Holy Grail.

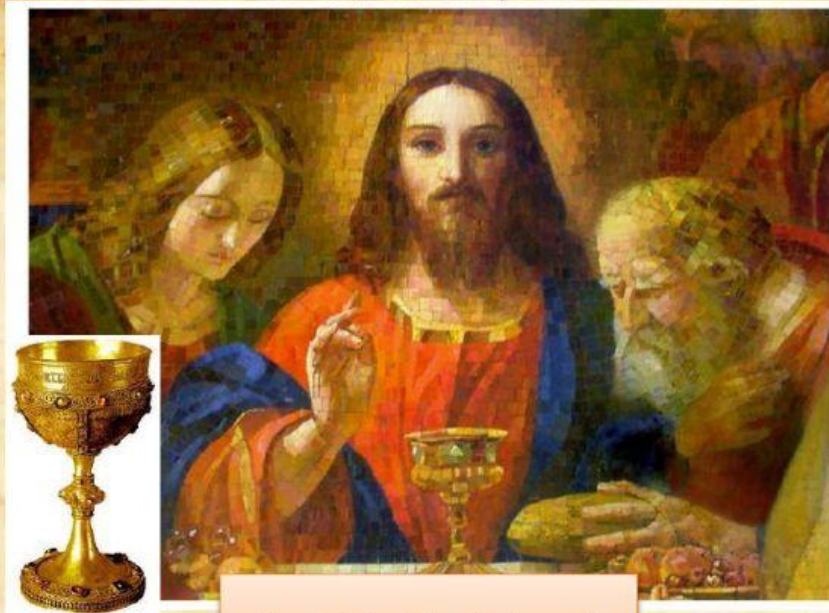
