

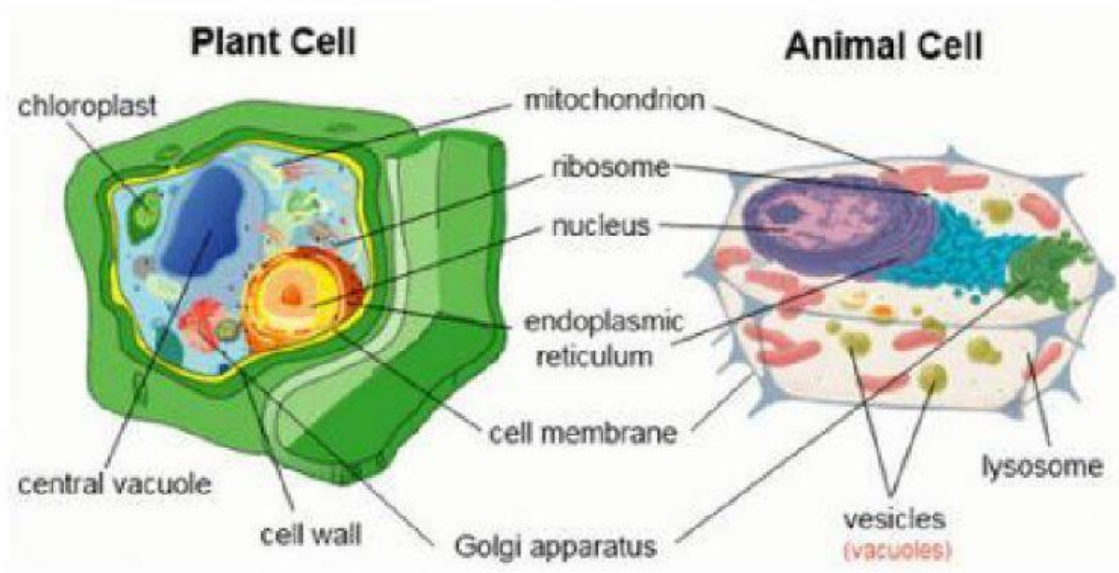

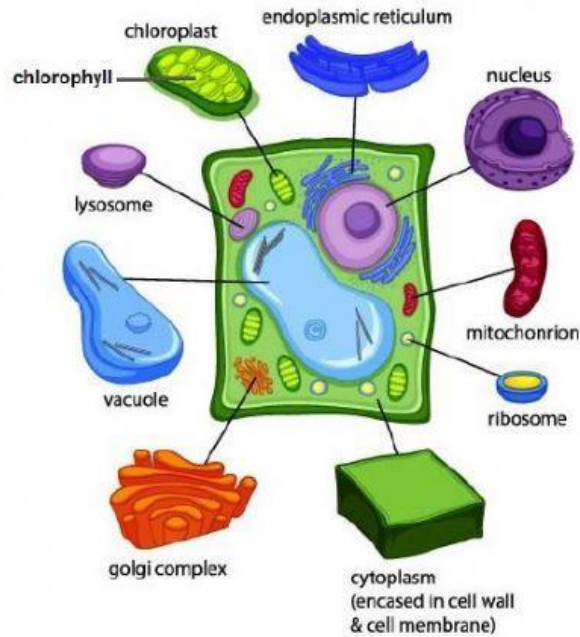

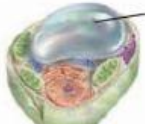


Parts of a Plant Cell
