Space travel began in the 20th century. In 1961, the Soviet Union sent the first man into space. Eight years later, NASA organized the first successful mission to the moon. Nowadays, even people who are not astronauts can go to space. They only need to be wealthy, because the cost of the flight is very high. The first space tourist was Dennis Tito, an American engineer, who paid \$20 million for a trip to the International Space Station in 2001. He used to work as a rocket scientist, then had a career in finance, but he never stopped dreaming about space travel. His favourite moment in space was when he talked over the radio to his children back home. The first female space tourist was Anousheh Ansari, an Iranian-born businesswoman. She wanted to fly in space so much that she said: 'I would go to space even if it was a one way ticket, if it meant going and never returning, if it meant losing my life over it!'. After her trip she published a memoir 'My Dream of Stars'. Guy Laliberté, a Canadian artist, has been the most unusual space tourist so far. He created One Drop Foundation, whose aim is to provide clean water to everybody on Earth. During his space trip in 2009, Guy organized an artistic event 'Moving Stars and Earth for Water' and had a space-to-earth conversation with Bono, the singer of U2. Scientists believe that in the future space tourism will be cheaper thanks to new technologies. If flight prices go down to \$50,000 per person, there may be half a million space tourists each year!
