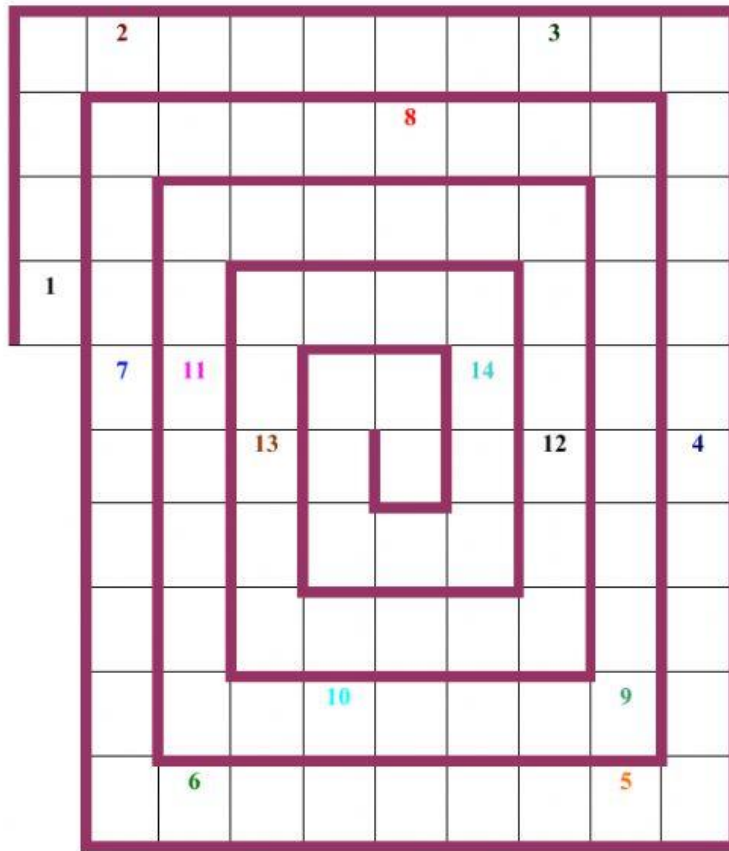


COMPARATIVE SPIRAL
