Viking bread was made from rye or barley flour. They used milk mostly to make cheese and butter.



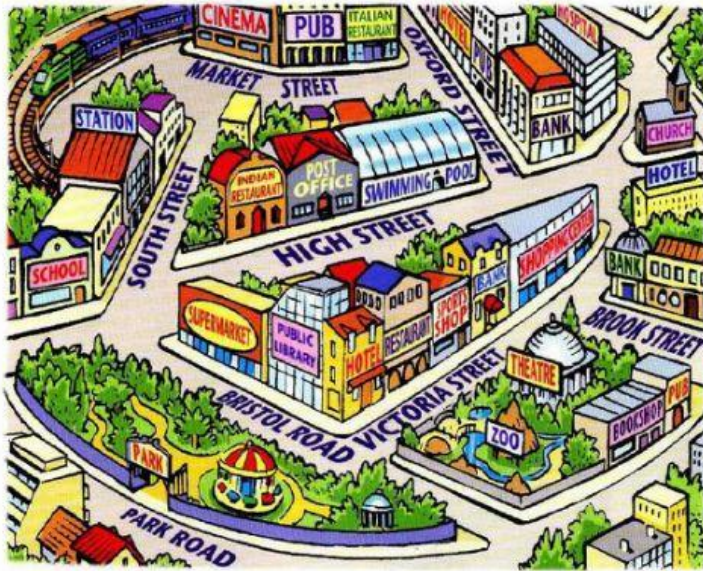
At a feast, guests drank a strong drink made from honey. People drank from wooden cups or drinking horns, made from cows. There were feasts for funerals and festivals.

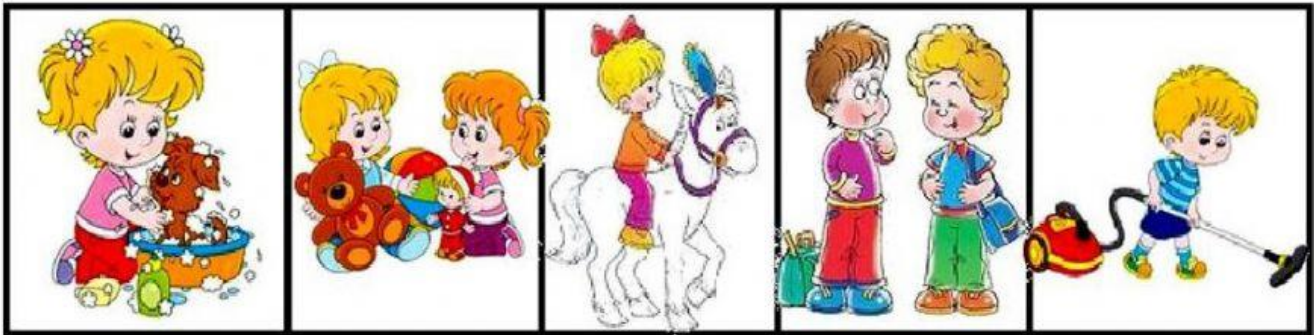
