### SECOND CONDITIONAL

We usually use it to **talk about improbable things that could happen in the future.**

If + *sujeto* + past simple, *sujeto* + would + verbo en infinitivo

Examples:

1. If she were my mom, I would try to make her happy.
2. If you were there, you would have the possibility to save her life.
