Simple Past or Past Perfect?

The two tenses are usually found in the same sentence when we need to talk about two actions that happened in the past and one of them took place **before** the other. The action that happened first must be in past **perfect**, while the **second** action in row must be in **simple past**.

Example: I **had already finished** my homework when the **lights went out**.



Time Expressions with the Past Perfect



Example: John does his homework.... The class starts.

- ✓ **By the time** the class started, John had done his homework.
- ✓ The class started **after** John had done his homework.
- ✓ John had done his homework **before** the class started.
- ✓ John had **already** done his homework when the class started.
- ✓ The class started at 6pm. **By then** John had done his homework.
- ✓ I had **just** finished my homework when the bell rang.
