World Pea Shooting Championships

Did you know that something naughty schoolchildren used to do is now a competitive sport? In the annual Cambridgeshire World Pea Shooting Championships, competitors have (0) blow a dried pea through a small tube called a blowpipe. They aim at a round target 3.5m away. The contest was first organised in 1971 by a teacher called John Tyson (9) had taken several blowpipes away (10) his pupils when they had used them at school.
