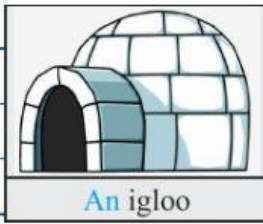


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Singular nouns "Indefinite articles"

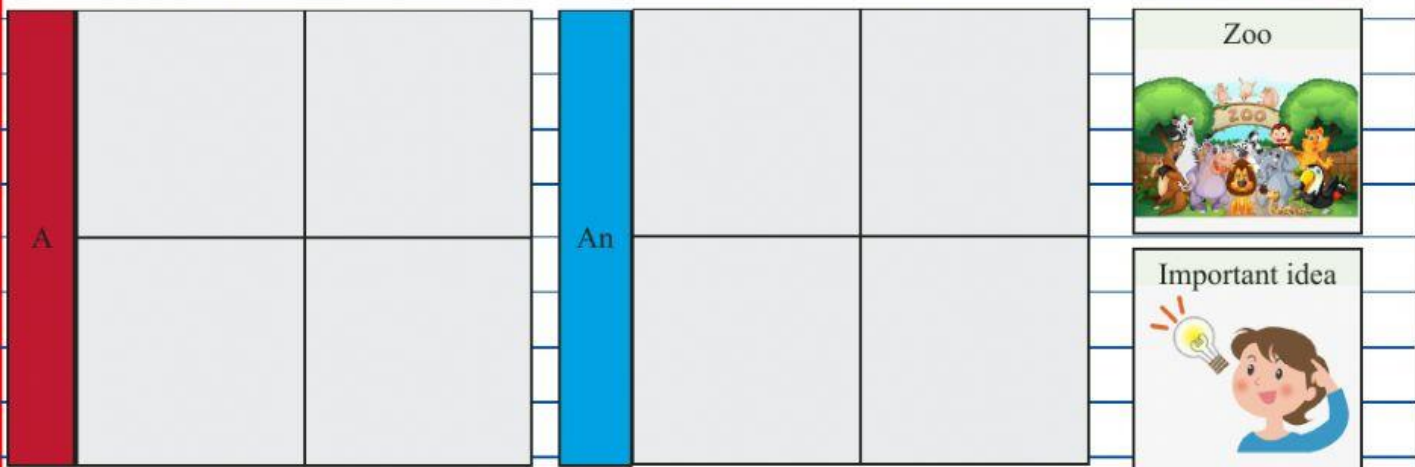
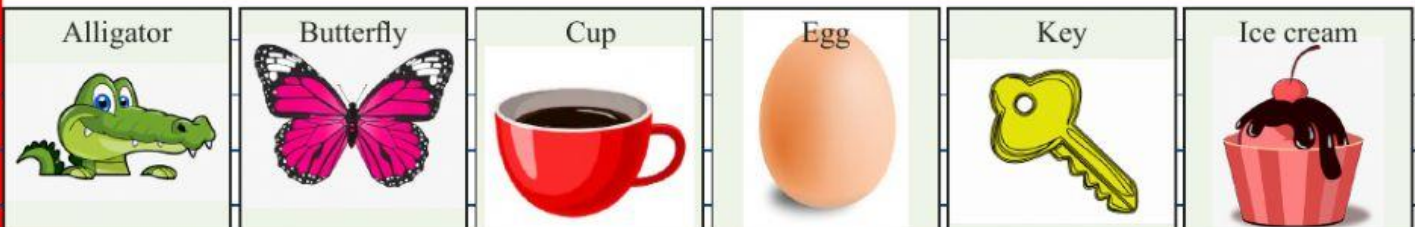
When you are talking about one person, animal, place or thing use a singular noun.



We use **A** if the following word starts with a consonant sound: **A** cat, **A** dog, **A** house, **A** soccer game, **A** building

We use **An** if the following word starts with a vowel sound: **An** apple, **An** orange, **An** elephant, **An** old man

1. Drag and drop the picture to the right place.



2. Indefinite article before U and H. Try to identify if it is a consonant or a vowel sound, and then write A or An
