REQUESTS: "Please don't shout." "Can you open the window?" "Could you close the door?"

Affirmative:	Subject + ASKED + Object + TO + Infinitive...
Negative:	Subject + ASKED + Object + NOT TO + Infinitive...

STATEMENTS: "I usually go to work by car." "We can't speak fluently."

Subject + SAID + THAT...
Subject + TOLD + Object + THAT...
