so + adjective

correct: She is **so** pretty.
Their house is **so** big.
This is **so** amazing!

incorrect: She is **so** pretty ~~woman~~.
Their house is **so** big ~~building~~.



such

such + a/an + adjective + noun

correct: He is **such** a handsome man.
They have **such** a big house.
This is **such** an amazing idea!

incorrect: He is ~~such~~ handsome.
Their house is ~~such~~ big.
