There are 3 groups.

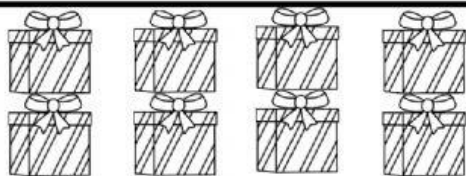
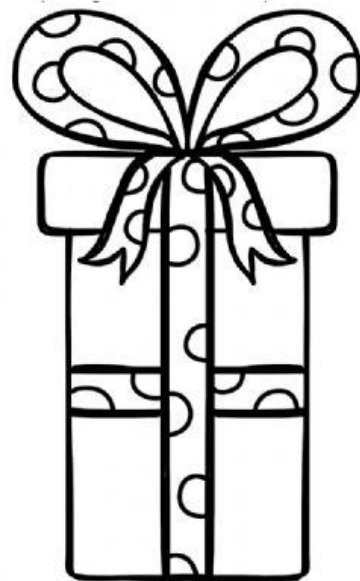
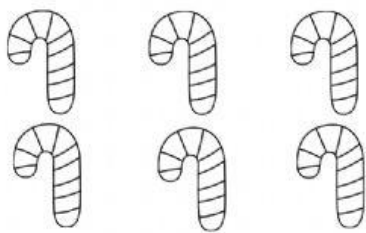
There are 2 in each group.

You can add.

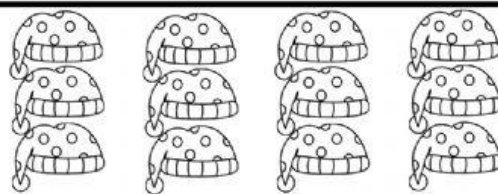
$$2 + 2 + 2 = 6$$

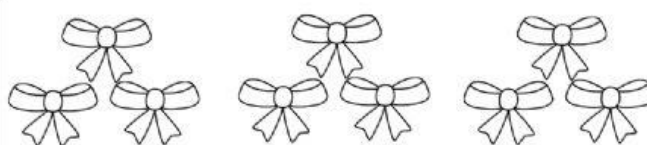

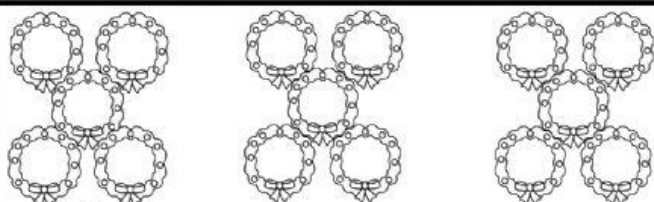
