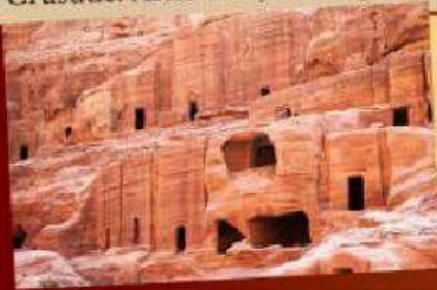
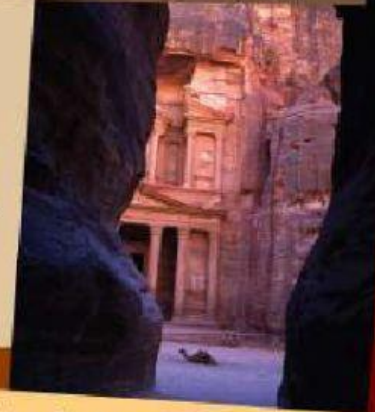
The Hidden City

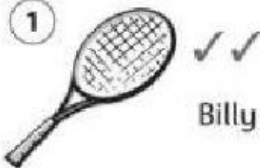

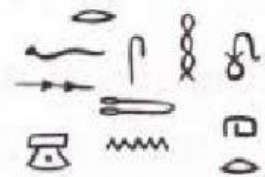
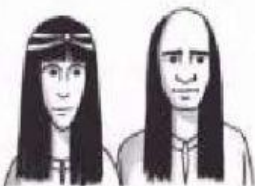
