Are they trains? Yes, they are.

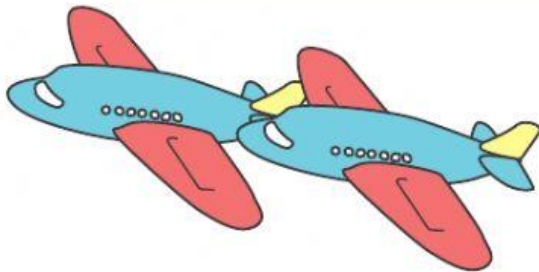
Are they planes? No, they aren't.

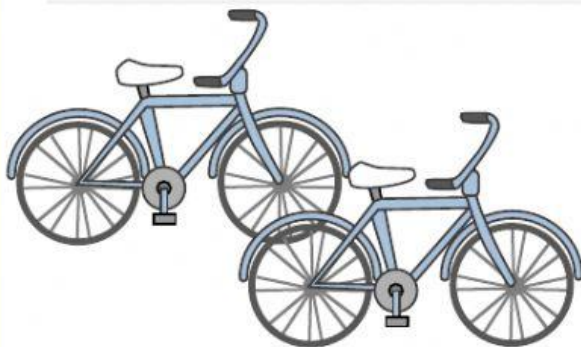
