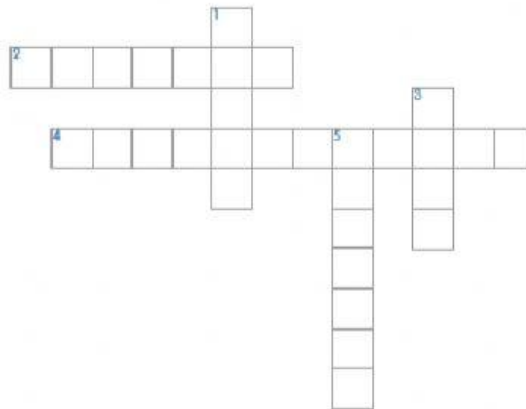

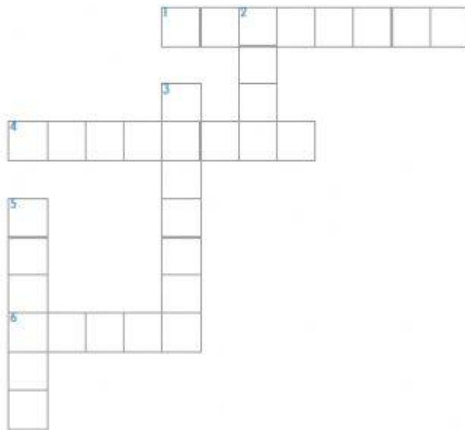
Going to the Doctor
