

Cycling to Eilat

I

- 20 Early the next morning they begin the last part of their bicycle trip. The sky is clear blue and there is no *sign of rain. They have another thirty kilometres to go before they reach the beach. They begin to sing to pass the time. Suddenly Ron, the leader, shouts out that Eilat is in front of them. It is good to see the "Welcome to Eilat" *sign. The long trip is over. They have arrived.
