PRESENT SIMPLE (WITH VERB 'TO BE')

*** Subject + am/is/are + Noun/Adjective/Preposition +... → (Wh-word) + be + Subject + n/adj/prep +...?

Ex:	She is beautiful.	→	Is she beautiful?
	She is beautiful. (Why)	→	Why is she beautiful?
—	John is a student.	→	_____
	John is in the class. (Where)	→	_____
—	They are at home at five.	→	_____

PRESENT SIMPLE (WITH ORDINARY/NORMAL VERBS)

*** Subject + V1 +... → *** (Wh- word) + do/does + Subject + V1 +...?

Ex:	Nita likes swimming.	→	_ Does Nita like swimming?
	Nita likes swimming. (What)	→	_ What does Nita like?
—	They come from England.	→	_____
	They come from England. (Where)	→	_____
—	He studies English at ACE.	→	_____
	He studies English at ACE. (What)	→	_____
—	I like wearing jeans.	→	_____
	I like wearing jeans. (Why)	→	_____

PAST SIMPLE

*** Subject + V2 +... → *** (Wh-word) + did + Subject + V1 +...?

Ex:	He cried last night.	→	Did he cry last night?
	He cried last night. (Why)	→	Why did he cry last night?
—	She met me yesterday.	→	_____
	She met me yesterday. (When)	→	_____
—	Hong slept under his bed.	→	_____
	Hong slept under his bed. (Where)	→	_____
—	Cheata watched cartoon last night.	→	_____
	Cheata watched cartoon. (what)	→	_____

PRESENT CONTINUOUS/PROGRESSIVE

*** Subject + be + Ving +... → *** (Wh-word) + be + Subject + Ving +...?

Ex:	My teacher is eating a cake.	→	Is your teacher eating a cake?
	My teacher is eating a cake. (What)	→	What is your teacher eating?
—	Pheap is chewing gum in class.	→	_____
	Pheap is chewing gum in class. (Where)	→	_____
—	They are playing hide-and-seek.	→	_____
	They are playing hide-and-seek. (What)	→	_____
