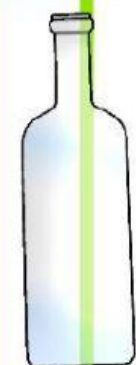




How to Recycle Paper at Home

Help save trees by recycling paper at home. First, gather all your old and unwanted newspapers, magazines, and catalogs. Then, separate the newspapers from the glossy paper inserts. The inserts go with magazines and catalogs to be recycled. Next, place each kind of paper in a separate pile. When you have a bundle that is about 10 inches (25 cm) high, tie up both lengthwise and around the middle with strong string. Finally, store your paper bundles in a dry place until recycling pickup day. If your community doesn't have a pickup day, find out where you can take your paper to be recycled.



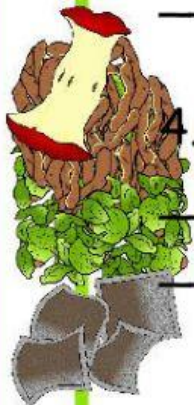
