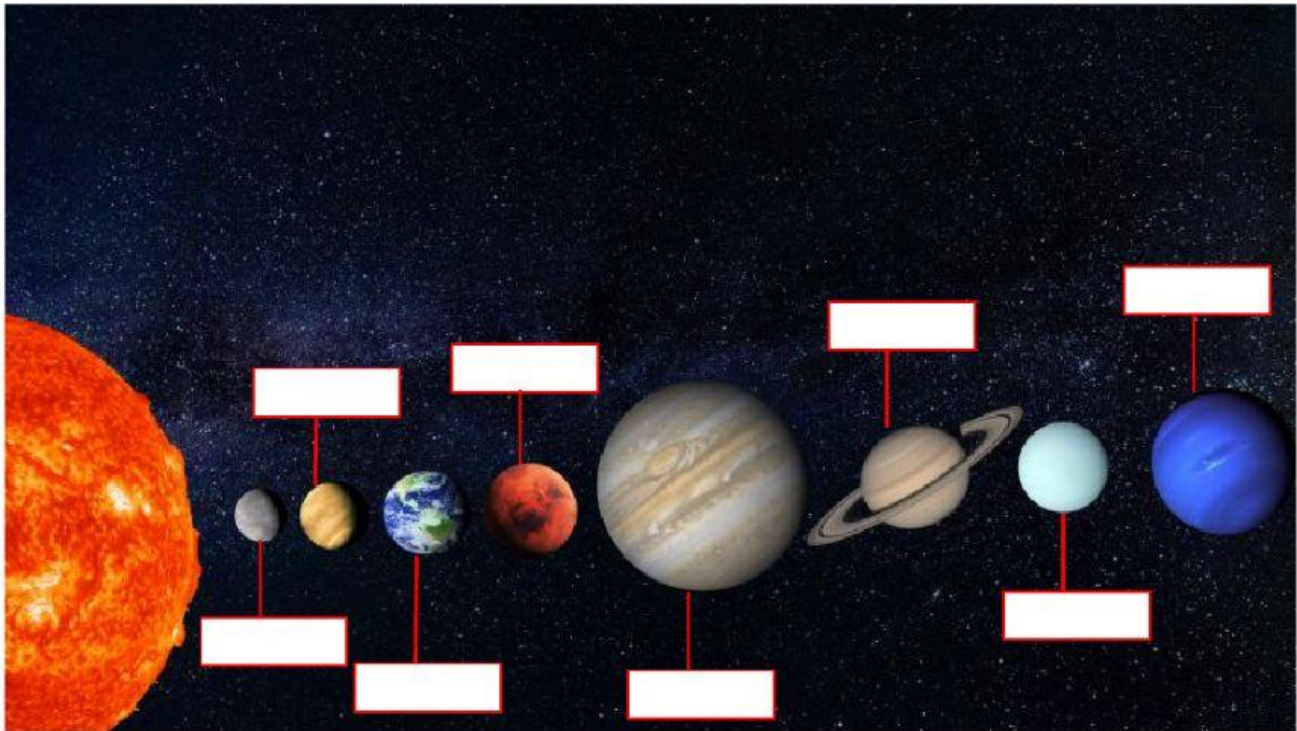


## Our Solar System
