

Order of Adjectives in a Sentence

There is some disagreement among linguists on how to order the adjectives in a sentence correctly. In *Practical English Usage* (Oxford), Michael Swan says that the subject is complicated, and that different grammars disagree about the details (as we'll see in a moment). But he gives 'some of the important ones:'
