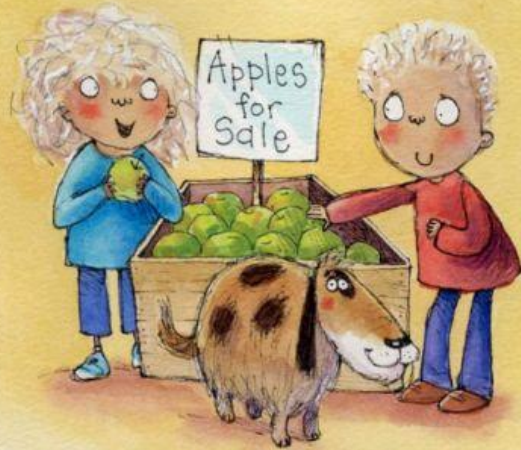

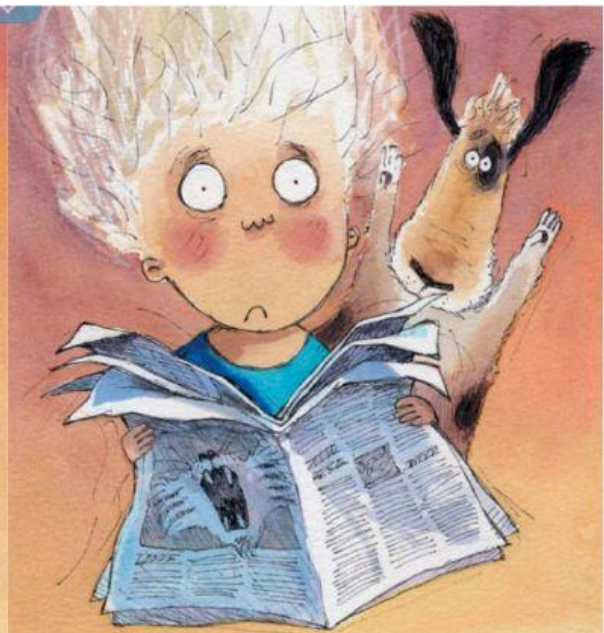
The calendar says,

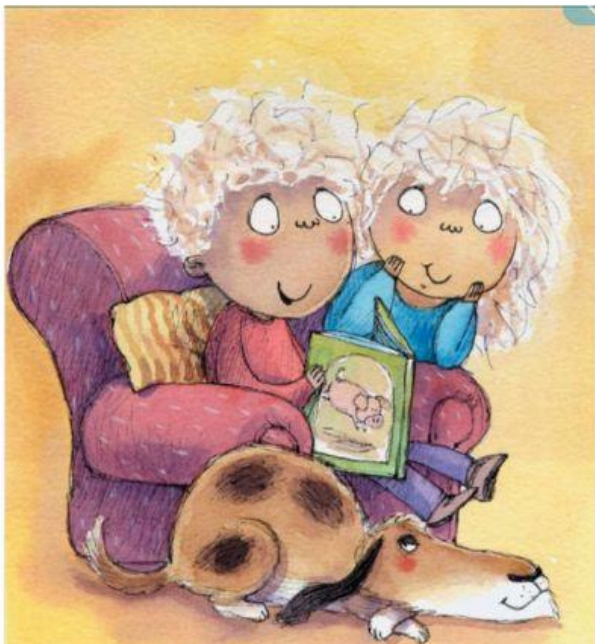
Can you read the newspaper?

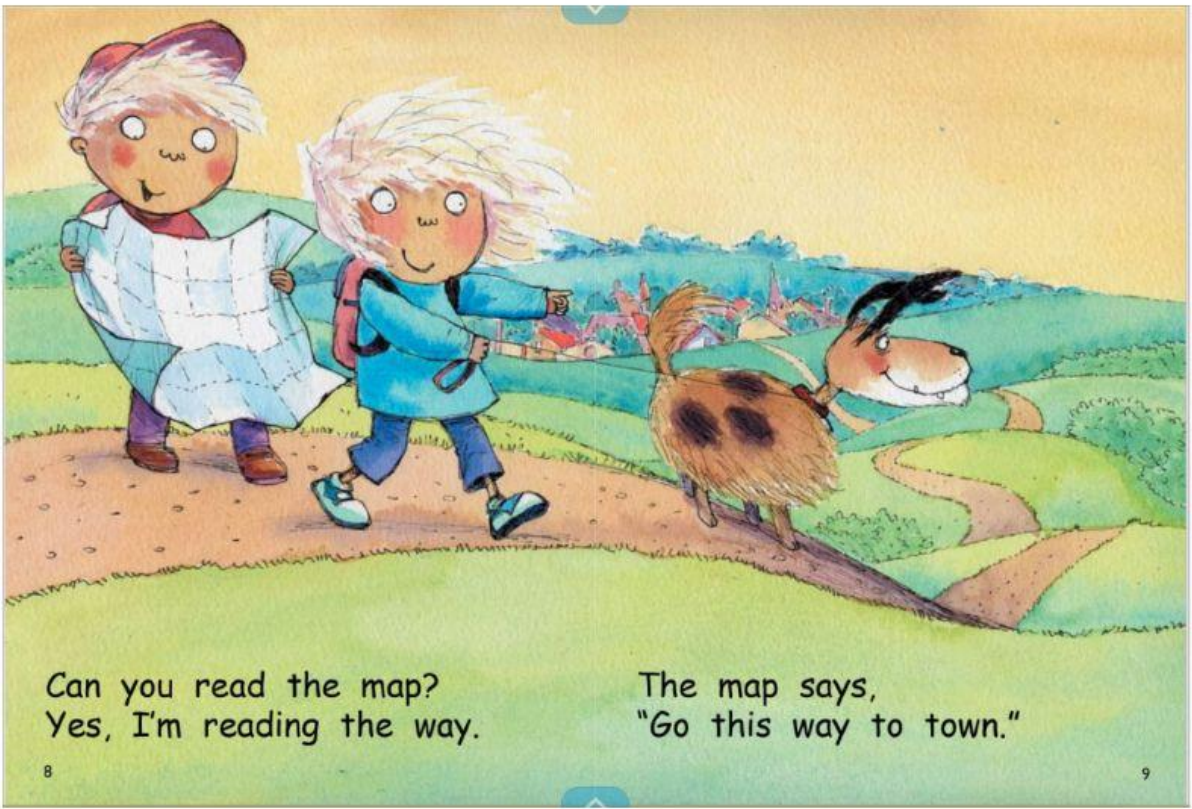
Can you read the book?

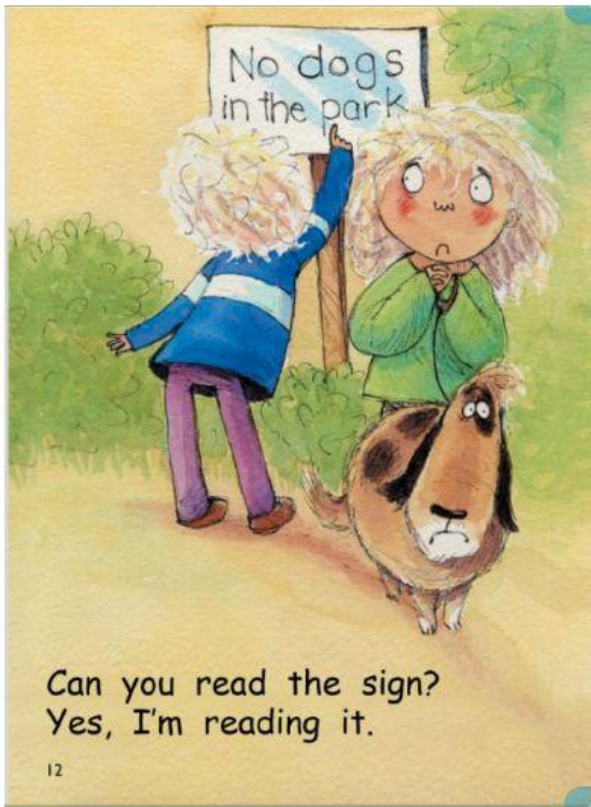

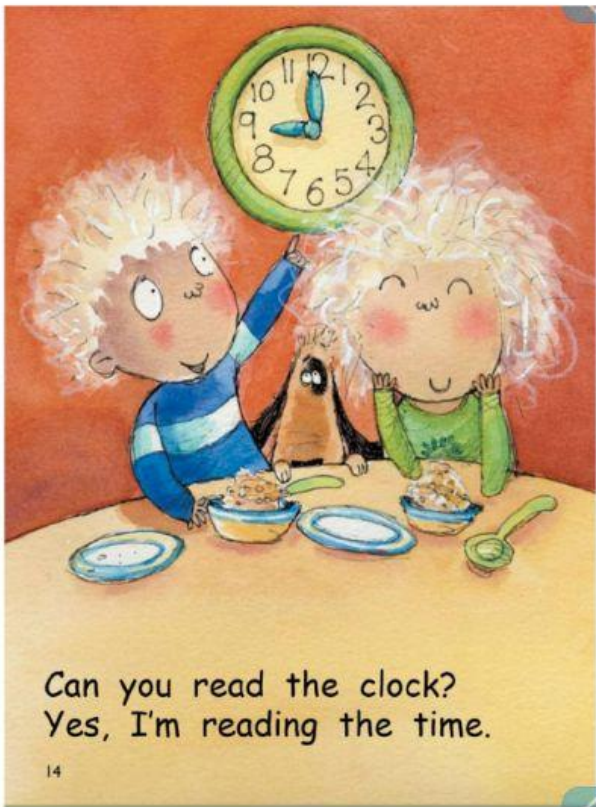

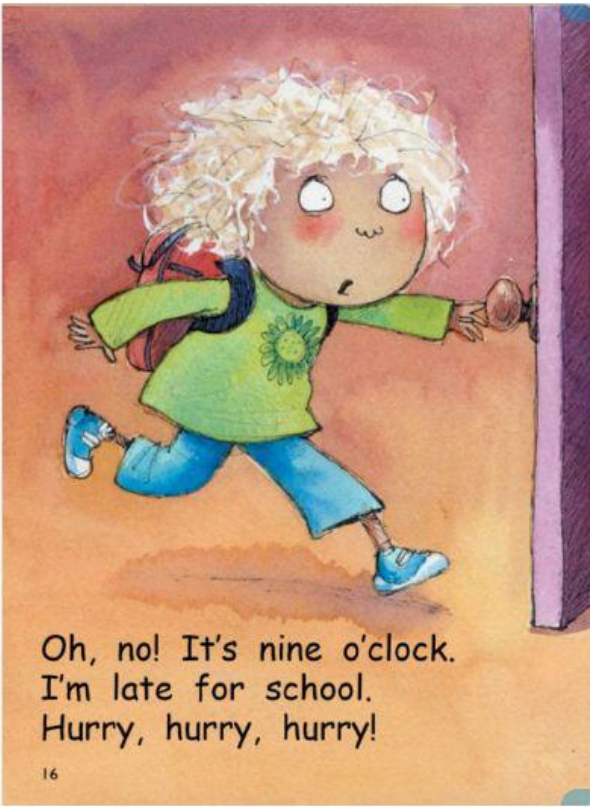
