\*Hang has two past simple forms: hung and hanged. The form hanged refers to when someone is subjected by law to death by hanging. The form hung is used in all situation not linked to the death of someone by hanging.

\* Be has two past simple forms. Was for HE, SHE, and IT. Were for I, YOU, WE, and THEY.

\*Lay and lie are usually confusing for non-native speakers so they must be seriously studied. Lie can be regular or irregular with difference in meaning. As regular, lie means not to tell the truth. The irregular form of lie takes the preposition down. So we have lie down as when someone lie on the floor or on a bed. Its past tense is lay and that is what can cause some sort of confusion.
