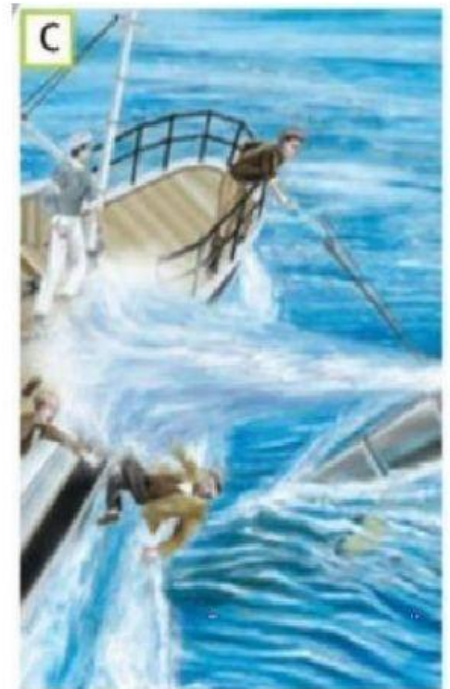
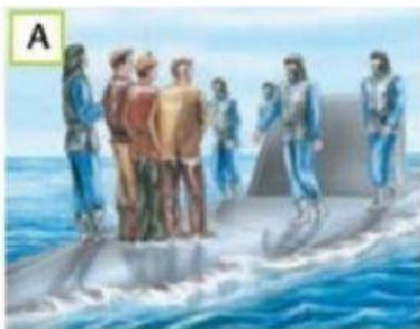

- She is **such** a beautiful girl.

We use **since** as a preposition, a conjunction and an adverb to refer to a time, and as a conjunction to introduce a reason.

- It's so long **since** I saw them.
