5. Macbeth thought of several reasons for not killing Duncan. Which ones?

6. How did Lady MacBeth persuade her husband to commit the murder?.

2. Read Act 2 and answer the questions.

- 1 Banquo was unhappy at the beginning of this act. Why?
- 2 What did Macbeth think that he saw before he committed the murder?
- 3 Describe how Duncan's dead body was discovered.
- 4 How did the following people react to the King's death?
(a) Macduff (b) Malcolm and Donalbain (c) Macbeth
(d) Lady Macbeth
- 5 What reason did Macbeth give for killing Duncan's servants?
What do you think his real reason was?
- 6 In your opinion, did Lady Macbeth really faint or was she acting?
Give reasons for your answer.
- 7 Malcolm was King Duncan's eldest son and heir. Why was Macbeth made king?

3. Read Act 3 and answer the questions.

- 1 Banquo believed that the three witches could foretell the future. How had their words already affected Macbeth and himself?
- 2 Macbeth decided that Banquo must be murdered. Why was that necessary?
- 3 Macbeth did not tell his wife about this murder. Why do you think he decided not to do this?
- 4 Banquo's son, Fleance, escaped. Why was Macbeth so unhappy about that?
- 5 If you were producing the play, would you have an actor come on stage as Banquo's ghost or not? Give reasons for your answer.
- 6 Macbeth made a decision at the end of this act. What was it?
- 7 This decision showed that Macbeth had changed. In what way had he changed?
- 8 People now suspected Macbeth of many murders. Who had decided to bring Macbeth's rule to an end and how did they plan to do it?

4. Read Act 4 and answer the questions

- 1 Why did Macbeth go to see the three witches again?
- 2 What were the witches doing when Macbeth found them?
- 3 The witches' masters told Macbeth about his future. Why was Macbeth reassured by what they said?
- 4 After seeing the three spirits, Macbeth asked the witches a question. What was this question?
- 5 Why was Macbeth horrified by what he saw next?
- 6 Why was Lady Macduff so angry with her husband in the second scene?
- 7 In your opinion, why did Macduff leave his family unprotected in Scotland?
- 8 Why did Malcolm tell Macduff lies about himself?
- 9 What did Macduff pray for?
