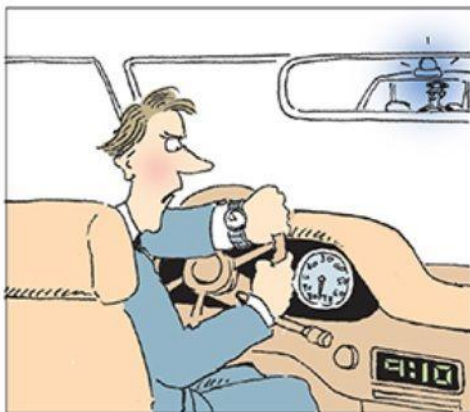

Hank didn't take a shower, and he didn't have any breakfast.

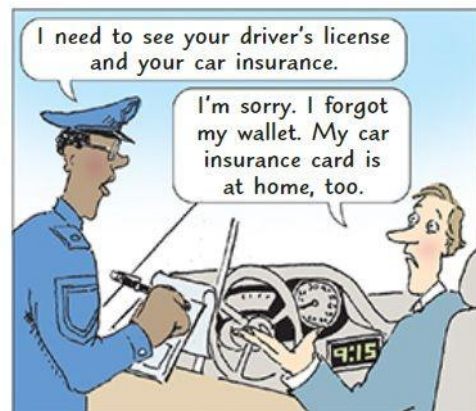
Hank didn't take a shower; in addition, he didn't have any breakfast.
