The next day, Anna comes to the bookshop with a present. She explains that her co-star is a notorious gossip and she was simply being discreet. Anna (1) *admits / complains* she still has feelings for him, apologises for her behaviour months (2) *ago / back* and explains that she now understands his comment that fame is nonsense.
