Suffering is a part of life's experiences. Most people view suffering as something negative. Suffering can however, produce positive characteristics in a person's life. Suffering helps to make individuals stronger and more resilient. They also gain wisdom and develop empathy.

Suffering can be an obstacle in a person's life if it causes an individual to lose hope and give up.

Two biblical examples of persons who suffered are Job and Joseph. Job was a righteous man. God allowed Satan to test Job by taking away his children and wealth. Job also endured sickness. Joseph endured great hardship after he was sold into slavery and imprisoned. Both of these individuals were rewarded for their patience and fortitude.

Suffering is a difficult experience but individuals must find ways to cope during such times. Here are several ways to cope during difficult times: • Pray to God; ask the Holy Spirit to strengthen and guide you • Talk to your parents, Pastor or counselor • Read the Bible • Listen to songs and poems that bring comfort • Encourage others who may be going through a similar experience

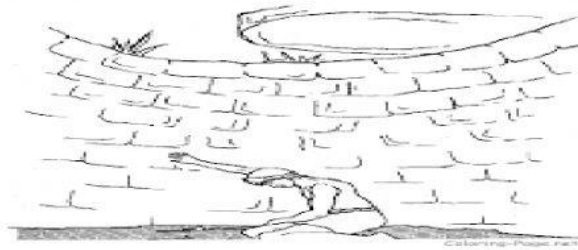

2. Use the picture below and your background knowledge from class discussions to help you answer questions 2a, 2b, 2c and 2d.



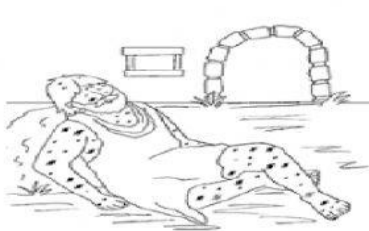
