TEOTIHUACAN RUINS

Teotihuacan was a major religious center as you'll see from the many religious monuments and structures found here. It was the Aztecs who gave Teotihuacán its name, when they arrived here in about 1320. The name means "City of Gods," and they believed the gods had gathered here to create the sun and moon after the last world ended. From their base in Tenochtitlan (in what is now Mexico City) they used it as pilgrimage destination.

Teotihuacan 5. _____ (be)(locate) about 50 km (30 miles) north of Mexico City, making it very doable as a day trip if you want to explore this fascinating ancient culture.
